SEAU MEMBERSHIP PROCESSING PROCEDURES

1. Anyone wishing to join SEAU and meeting the requirements for any grade of membership listed should complete the application. The application and first years annual dues should be sent to SEAU, P.O. Box 581292, Salt Lake City, UT 84158-1292
2. Once the application is received, it will be processed and member's information will be added to the SEAU membership record. The name of the applicant will be published in the SEAU newsletter for the general membership.
3. Members changing grade within the Association shall not be required to pay any additional dues during the fiscal year of the change.
4. If the application is received between February 1st and March 31st, then 50% of the dues will be required. Dues received between April 1st and May 31st will be applied to the next fiscal year.
5. Once the applicant's monies have been received and the application processed, the President will be notified and he in turn will send the new member a membership certificate.
6. The applicant should allow up to 60 days for application processing.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

1. Professional SE Grade:
\$100 annual dues. (See item 4 above)
A professional SE registered in the State of Utah with authority to use the title Structural Engineer, and regularly engaged in the practice of structural or related engineering.
2. Professional Grade:
\$100 annual dues. (See item 4 above)
A professional engineer registered in the State of Utah, and regularly engaged in the practice of structural or related engineering.
3. Associate Grade:
\$55 annual dues. (See item 4 above)
An associate grade member at the time of acceptance of their application to the Association shall have been regularly engaged for at least 4 years in structural or related engineering. Graduation in engineering from an accredited college or university with a degree in civil, structural, or related engineering may be considered by the Board of Directors as the equivalent of 4 years experience. An associate grade member may be an individual who is a Professional Engineer, but not registered in Utah. An associate may hold no office and shall have no vote.
4. Affiliate Grade:
\$100 annual dues. (See item 4 above)
An affiliate grade member shall, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, be qualified for membership by reason of position, to cooperate with the Association in the advancement of the professional knowledge, practice and welfare. An affiliates' connection with the Association shall cease when the individual no longer holds a position qualifying for membership. An affiliate may hold no office and shall have no vote.
5. Student Grade:
\$10 annual dues. (See item 4 above)
A student at the time of acceptance of their application to the Association is a full-time or part-time undergraduate or full-time graduate student enrolled in an accredited civil, structural or related engineering program at a college or university. A student may hold no office and shall have no vote.
